Pending Acquisition by Cirrus Industries Announced by Rhino Aviation/SATSair

Greenville, South Carolina (November 8, 2005) – SATSair, a provider of "Air Taxi" services operated by Rhino Aviation, announced today that they have signed documents that are expected to lead to the acquisition of SATSair by Cirrus Industries. Under the agreement, SATSair will become a wholly owned subsidiary of Cirrus, which expects to expand the service area and fleet by adding more than 100 new aircraft over the coming year.

Steve Hanvey, President/CEO of SATSair, spoke during the Cirrus press conference at the AOPA Expo 2005, stating that the company name will be changed exclusively to SATSair in the near future and that there will be no change in operations or employment due to the pending deal with Cirrus. SATSair will continue to operate on its model of proven success with Steve Hanvey and Tim McConnell at the helm.

"Cirrus and SATSair/Rhino Aviation are announcing that we have signed documents that are expected to lead to an acquisition of our company by Cirrus soon," Steve said at the press conference. "We will then operate as a wholly owned subsidiary of Cirrus Industries. This has been an ongoing process since before Oshkosh."

During the AOPA Expo, Steve also participated in a taped interview, about the air taxi concept and Cirrus with Jim "Zoom" Campbell, Editor-in-Chief of Aero-News Network and Dale Klapmeier, co-founder of Cirrus, for a 30 minute audio that will be available at www.aero-news.net.

SATSair, operated by Rhino Aviation, is the first to offer the innovative "Air Taxi" concept based on extensive research and strategic relationships with agencies such as NASA and the FAA. Using new Cirrus SR22 aircraft, SATSair's mission is to provide safe, convenient, economical air travel and top-notch customer service.
